- Indian Institute of Technology Hyderabad hosted the first ever 'Japan Day' event to further expand collaboration in Research and Development between the two countries and enhance career opportunities for IIT-H students in Japan. Interactions between the Japanese industry and i-TIC foundation at IIT Hyderabad was also held. The programme also included mutual sessions between the IIT-H startups and Japanese companies.
- i-TIC received a CSR grant of Rs. 25 Lakhs in FY 2018-19 for funding the incubatees (beneficiaries are yet to be shortlisted and announced)

Out of the 25 start-ups selected by HDFC Bank to receive Parivartan Grants, nine are from Hyderabad. The grant was set up by the Bank to support start-ups working in the social sector space and who are offering unique solutions that bring a sustainable change.
